



JACK DRESSLAR KIAAA SCHOLARSHIP

Each year, the members of the KIAAA are proud to award the prestigious *Jack Dresslar Kansas Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association Scholarship* to four deserving Kansas student-athletes. Scholarships are sponsored by Future Pro and Vype High School Sports Magazine.

ELIGIBILITY

1. The applicant must be nominated by the athletic director of their school and the athletic director must be a member of both the KIAAA and the NIAAA
2. The applicant must be a senior attending a Kansas State High School Activities Association member school
3. The race, color, creed, or gender of the applicant will not be a factor in determining eligibility for this scholarship
4. Applicant must attend an accredited college or trade school, the following year after graduating from high school, as a full time student
5. The applicant must show personal achievement through scholastic work, extra-curricular activities, memberships in organizations, community involvement, all of which are utmost importance
6. Only 1 female and 1 male may be nominated from their respective school

TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP

Outright scholarship grant and non-renewable

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Four (4) \$500.00 scholarships, one in each of the four congressional districts of the state (One year only)

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

1. The applicant must be nominated by the athletic director of their school and the athletic director must be member of KIAAA and NIAAA
2. Applicant must have achieved at least two (2) of the following: (a) minimum of B+ average; (b) ranked in the top 25% of class; (c) ACT score of 24 or an SAT score of 1100
3. Applicant must have participated in two sports for two years in each sport
4. Applicant must have earned at least one varsity letter in each of two sports
5. Applicant must complete attached scholarship application
6. Applicant must have two (2) letters of recommendation, one from the school's athletic director and one from non-family and non-school personnel
7. The principal or athletic administrator must sign the application to ensure that the academic information submitted is accurate
8. A typed essay of not less than 250, nor more than 500 words on "How High School Athletics Has Impacted My Life"

SELECTION PROCESS

1. After all applications are received they will be forwarded to the KIAAA district representatives who will narrow the applications to 3 finalists. These finalists will be sent to the scholarship committee.
2. The scholarship committee (KIAAA past presidents) will review and select the winning applicants based on the above criteria.
3. The decision of the scholarship committee shall be final and absolute.
4. All winners will be invited and expected to attend the KIAAA Awards Luncheon on **March 17, 2012**, at the Wichita Airport Hilton, Wichita, Kansas.
